## ICC ANNOUNCES NEW EVALUATION SERVICE LEADERSHIP

Moinian is a licensed mechanical engineer (California and Ohio) with a Master of Engineering in mechanical engineering from Cal-Poly, Pomona. He lives in Rancho Cucamonga, Calif.
