ICC-ES Issues New PMG Listings to American Faucet and Coatings Corporation

[PMG-1140](#) verifies AFCC's plumbing supply fittings are in compliance with NSF 372 – 2010, Drinking Water System Components – Lead Content Reduction of Lead in Drinking Water Act, the California Health and Safety Code 116875, S.3874 - Reduction of Lead in Drinking Water Act and Maryland's Lead Free Law HB 372.
